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## DESCRIPTION

The curriculum is designed to train front-line health workers to provide culturally responsive services in Michigan communities. Each of the eight [8] MiCHWA-recognized CHW Core Competencies are presented in modules that promote the development of skills needed to become gainfully employed as a CHW and enhance the knowledge base of those already employed. The internship consists of field experiences in local agencies where the student applies and integrates their course work into practice. Participants currently employed as CHWs will complete internship at their place of work. *To maintain MiCHWA CHW Certification, participants must complete 20 Continuing Education Unites (CEUs) every two years and annually renew MiCHWA CHW Registry Membership (\$30 per year).*

## TRAINING PRE-REQUISITES

- High School Diploma or GED
  - Good oral, reading, and written communication skills
  - Basic computer skills
- If not currently working as a CHW or in a CHW-related role:**
- Interview with the Instructor
  - Independent work in a community setting
